POLICY REGARDING OFFICERS

1. The Board shall, not later than one month after the date on which newly elected members take office, elect from its own members a Chairman, Vice-Chairman, Secretary and a Public Relations Officer.
2. Officers shall hold their respective offices for one year and until their successors are duly elected.
3. Should a vacancy arise in an office of the Board, the members of the Board (including, if applicable, the member vacating a Board office) shall elect a successor to fill the office until the next regular election for Board officers.
4. The votes of each member cast in such election shall be reduced to writing and made available for public inspection within forty-eight hours, excluding Saturday, Sunday, or legal holidays, and shall also be available for inspection at all reasonable times.
5. If such officers are not chosen after one month because of a tie vote of the members the Board of Selectman of the town shall choose such officers from the membership of the board.
